

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-798**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TOWN'S BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of North Redington Beach adopted a budget for fiscal year 2017-2018 by and through Ordinance 2017-789; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners desires to amend the budget by transferring \$46,000 from unassigned reserved funds to Fund 3 – Special Revenue/Capital Improvement Fund in order to fund the purchase of a generator (\$24,000) and check valves (\$22,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the loss of power following Hurricane Irma demonstrated a need for a generator that can be used to power the sewer lift stations in the absence of electricity; and

**WHEREAS**, the installation of check valves in low areas of Town should eliminate street flooding due to high tide; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of North Redington Beach has determined that amendment to the budget is necessary to appropriately fund and account for such purchase.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** – That the Town's 2017-2018 budget is hereby amended as stated herein.

**Section 2.** – This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and adoption.
