



**TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 1ST, 2017 MINUTES**

CALL TO ORDER

The March 1st, 2017 special meeting was called to order by Mayor Bill Queen at 2:30 p.m. The meeting was held at the Town Hall building, 190 - 173rd Avenue East, North Redington Beach, Florida.

Vice Mayor Ted Dahl and Commissioners Gary Curtis, Richard Bennett and Kevin Kennedy were present.

A. DISCUSS ENGAGEMENT OF ATTORNEY BILL BRINTON

Town Attorney Daigneault presented the Board with the curriculum vitae and proposal from Attorney Bill Brinton to construct a new sign ordinance for a flat fee of \$10k. Town Attorney Daigneault explained that at the current time, and for approximately a year during the appeal process, the town would have no sign regulations unless a new sign ordinance was adopted.

The Board discussed the need to proceed with the appeal if the new ordinance was written, as a lack of sign ordinance was the basis of the decision to appeal. Town Attorney Daigneault advised the Board to hold off on making the decision until he could speak with Mr. Lirot, the attorney handling the appeal.

The Board discussed the steps of getting the new ordinance in place and agreed to go forward with hiring Mr. Brinton.

During public input, Jeff Bush, resident of South Bath Club, stated he felt it was the right decision.

Commissioner Gary Curtis made a motion to retain Mr. Brinton per the arrangements outlined in the proposal. Vice Mayor Dahl seconded the motion.


