ORDINANCE NO. 2018-796 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES, AMENDING CHAPTER 98, (ZONING), ARTICLE VI, (SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS), DIVISION 1 (GENERALLY), CREATING SECTION 98-367, (LIGHTNING RODS AND STORM DETECTION SYSTEMS); PROVIDING FOR THE HEIGHT LIMITATION OF LIGHTNING RODS AND STORM DETECTION SYSTEMS WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH; PROVIDING FOR LEGAL NONCONFORMITIES; PROVIDING FOR LEGISLATIVE INTENT; FINDING THE AMENDMENTS CONSISTENT WITH THE TOWN'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVERNER'S CORRECTIONS AND INTERNAL CONSISTENCY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.
