



**TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
PUBLIC HEARING FOR TENTATIVE MILLAGE
AND PROPOSED BUDGET
SEPTEMBER 12TH, 2018 MINUTES**

CALL TO ORDER

The September 6TH, 2018 public hearing for the tentative millage and proposed budget was called to order by Mayor Bill Queen at 5:15 p.m. The meeting was held at the Town Hall building, 190 - 173rd Avenue, North Redington Beach, Florida.

Board members present were: Mayor Bill Queen, Vice Mayor Ted Dahl and Commissioners Richard Bennett, Gary Curtis and Kevin Kennedy.

PUBLIC HEARING ON TENTATIVE MILLAGE AND PROPOSED BUDGET

Mayor Queen stated the proposed millage was 6.18% above the “roll-back” rate of .9418 for this coming fiscal year.

Commissioner Bennett read the ordinance approving the proposed millage rate.

A. ORDINANCE NO. 2018-802 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2018 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, AT THE RATE OF 1.0 MILLS; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECOND AND FINAL READING.

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve ordinance No. 2018-802. Commissioner Bennett seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken.

Commissioner Curtis read the ordinance approving the proposed budget.

B. ORDINANCE NO. 2018-803 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET AND MILLAGE RATE FOR THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2018 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE SCHEDULES SETTING FORTH ESTIMATED ANTICIPATED EXPENDITURES AND ESTIMATED REVENUES; PROVIDING FOR AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PAY OPERATING EXPENDITURES, CAPITAL EXPENDITURES, DEBTS, DEBT SERVICES AND MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURES; APPROPRIATING AND ALLOCATING FUNDS, REVENUES, SERVICE CHARGES, FINES AND FORFEITURES, TAXES, REVENUE-SHARING; LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES SUBJECT TO TAXATION WITHIN THE TOWN AT THE RATE OF 1.0 MILLS; DIRECTING THAT AD VALOREM TAXES SHALL BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED FOR THE

CALENDAR YEAR 2018, PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET AND MILLAGE RATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECOND AND FINAL READING.

Commissioner Kennedy made a motion to approve ordinance no. 2018-803. Commissioner Bennett seconded the motion. There was no public input. A roll call vote was taken.
