ORDINANCE NO. 2018 – 799 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 74 OF THE TOWN CODE TO CONFIRM THE PUBLIC’S LONG-STANDING CUSTOMARY USE OF THE DRY SAND AREAS OF THE TOWN’S BEACHES, CLARIFYING WHICH USES ARE PERMITTED AND PROHIBITED FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ON THE DRY SAND AREAS OF THE BEACH THAT ARE OWNED BY PRIVATE PARTIES; PROVIDING FOR A BUFFER AREA AROUND PRIVATE PERMANENT STRUCTURES; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; MAKING RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
