DOGS, PARKING & PEDESTRIAN SAFETY~ Dog owners need to pick up after their pets and be aware if they are barking excessively (especially if they remain in the yard for long periods of time). Dogs must be leashed at all times on public property. On the backstreets in town there is only parking allowed on one side of the street. All parking restrictions are marked with signage. If you are parking on the street please make sure you are on the correct side of the road and facing the correct direction. Otherwise, you may receive a parking ticket. Also, please remember the speed limit on the backstreets is 25 mph. Safety tip - when walking on our backstreets after dark please wear light colored clothing or walk with a flash light. Always walk facing the traffic, use the crosswalks where available and always watch for cars. Please observe all these rules/suggestions - they are for the safety of everyone.

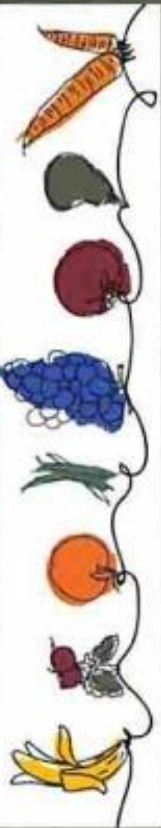
