



**TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
WORKSHOP MINUTES  
OCTOBER 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2018**

*Mayor Bill Queen called the October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 workshop to order at 10:00 a.m. Vice Mayor Ted Dahl and Commissioner Kennedy were present. The meeting was held at the Town Hall Building, 190 - 173<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, North Redington Beach.*

**A. EMERGENCY SERVICES BUILDING**

*Mayor Queen said he had met with Mark Woodard, Pinellas County Administrator, regarding the planned EMS building. Mr. Woodard stated he would suggest the towns (Redington Shores, Redington Beach and North Redington) pay 20% of the construction cost of the building which would equal \$400k (\$2 million to build). The County would own the building and would pay for all repairs and insurance. The town would lease them the land. The Mayors agreed on a split of NRB 50%, RS 35% and RB 15% based on the usage of the building. Those percentages amount to NRB \$200k, RS \$140k and RB \$60k. The Board agreed that it was a good deal and the building was much needed. Town Clerk Campbell stated she had given Commissioner Bennett and Commissioner Curtis the breakdown and they were ok with the amount to be paid. Mayor Queen reiterated the impetus of building the facility was to improve fire and ems times which has been substandard over the years. Mayor Queen said he was attending the PC Board of Commissioners meeting on October 9<sup>th</sup> to discuss the project.*

*Mayor Queen also mentioned the new fire agreements were ready and would be on an upcoming agenda.*

**B. MISCELLANEOUS**

*Commissioner Kennedy spoke about the beach renourishment.*

*There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:07 a.m.*
