BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup>, 2016 MINUTES**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Queen called the September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Town Hall building, 190 - 173<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, North Redington Beach, Florida.

Mayor Queen, Vice Mayor Dahl and Commissioners Bennett, Curtis and Kennedy were present.
