**Coyotes** Coyotes (*Canis latrans*) have been in Florida since the 1970's and are everywhere in Pinellas County – even out here on the beaches. They are omnivores and will eat just about anything including wild fruits, insects, birds and other small mammals. They also can prey on cats, small dogs, livestock, garbage and pet food. Coyotes are very shy and often difficult to spot. If they do not keep their distance they should be avoided. They can carry lethal rabies. Stay away from coyotes, they are common wildlife in Florida – remember wildlife is wild. Pinellas County Codes forbids molesting, feeding or releasing wild or non-native animals within Pinellas County. Report any coyote that is not fearful of humans or does not keep its distance to Animal Services at 727-582-2600. **Resident Parking Permits** Please check your Resident Parking Permit. The neon green permits are set to expire in December 2015 and you will need to get a new one. Please bring in your photo identification (proof of residency) to Town Hall to get a new neon orange permit that is valid through December 2017. There is no charge.
