Holiday Events This holiday season will be upon us very soon. Join in on the festivities starting with the Holiday Tree Lighting at Radcliffe Park - Friday, December 5th at 6:00 pm; the Home Decorating Contest judges will be traveling the town on Thursday, December 18th and the Holiday Boat Parade sails by on Sunday, December 21st. The Town is also holding its annual Food Drive beginning November 3rd thru November 20th. Please drop off your non-perishable food at Town Hall to help stock the shelves of the Beach Community Food Bank in Indian Rocks Beach.

Disaster Re-Entry Program The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office is revamping the disaster re-entry program which will require new re-entry cards to be distributed to all residents. The replacement cards will be bar coded to help the Sheriff's Office be much more efficient and effective than the current system. This program is in the final stages of preparation and the new cards will be distributed through Town Hall when they become available.

Keeping the Beaches Clean Over the past few years Town Hall has received many complaints regarding tents being left overnight on the beach. The problem has now expanded to chairs, coolers, toys, towels, etc. Several of the complaints received were from the motels/hotels commenting on how unsightly the beach has been. The Board of Commissioners passed Ordinance 2014-750 that makes it unlawful to leave any property (including tent frames) on the beach between the hours of 8 pm – 8 am. Any items left will be considered abandoned and will be removed from the beach. Most of the other beach communities have similar rules as the one we recently enacted. Hopefully by distributing flyers to the hotels and posting signs along the beach accesses, compliance will be quickly achieved.

Park Updates The Town continues to improve our parks on a yearly basis. The recently installed exercise machines at Radcliffe Park have been well received with many people enjoying them. The improvements continue as this year we will be adding decorative fencing to several of our parks. Please enjoy our wonderful recreation areas that include tennis courts, a basketball hoop, exercise equipment, children's play areas, gazebos, picnic tables and beautiful views of Gulf of Mexico.

Small Town USA We recently read an article about life in small towns in America. The two biggest complaints were barking dogs and parking issues. That certainly sounds familiar. Dog owners need to pick up after their pet(s) and be aware if they are barking excessively (especially if they remain in the yard for long periods of time).
