BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING  
FEBRUARY 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2010 MINUTES**

**CALL TO ORDER**

SECOND AND FINAL READING.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Ordinance no. 2010-688. Vice Mayor Knight seconded the motion. Vice Mayor Knight explained the change to the comprehensive plan was a wording change required by state statute to keep the town's plan in compliance. There was no public input.

**2. ORDINANCE NO. 2010-689 AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO PARKING ON GULF BOULEVARD; PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING OF VEHICLES OVER SEVEN FEET IN HEIGHT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECOND AND FINAL READING.**

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Ordinance no. 2010-689. Commissioner Blocker seconded the motion. Mayor Queen reiterated the change in the ordinance was brought about by a large step van that was parked on Gulf Boulevard. He again mentioned that Mr. Messmore helped resolve that particular situation but the board decided a change was needed to prevent future issues. There was no public input.

**3. ORDINANCE NO. 2010-690 AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE TOWN'S SANITATION CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE CONTRACT WITH WASTE SERVICES OF FLORIDA, INC. FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE YEARS UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. SECOND AND FINAL READING.**

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Ordinance no. 2010-690. Commissioner Curtis seconded the motion. Mayor Queen explained that Waste Services had agreed to extend the current contract for three years at the same rates. Mr. Dahl asked if there had been a bid. Mayor Queen explained the board was not required to go out for bid and was happy that Waste Services had agreed to extend the contract without any increase in rates.
