- ORDINANCE NO. 2013-735** AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 38-4 OF ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 38 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, TO DELETE THE REFERENCE TO VEHICLES EXHIBITING LETTERING OR LOGOS ADVERTISING A BUSINESS FROM THE DEFINITION OF "COMMERCIAL VEHICLE"; TO DELETE THE REFERENCE TO STORAGE BOXES OR LOCKERS FROM THE DEFINITION OF "COMMERCIAL VEHICLE"; TO DELETE THE REFERENCE TO VANS THAT DO NOT HAVE SEATING BEHIND THE DRIVER'S SEAT AND THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT WITHOUT SIDE WINDOWS ADJACENT TO THE REAR SEATING AREA SUCH AS PANEL VANS FROM THE DEFINITION OF "COMMERCIAL VEHICLE"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2013-735. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Curtis. Mayor Queen explained the ordinance was amended to allow company vehicles with writing but keeps other restrictions. The Board voted with the following results:

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-736 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 30-57 OF ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, TO PROVIDE A PROVISION FOR FRONT YARD GARDENS BY CALENDAR YEAR YEARLY PERMIT; TO ESTABLISH THE REQUIREMENTS FOR AND RESTRICTIONS TO FRONT YARD GARDENS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.

Commissioner Curtis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2013-736. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Mayor Queen stated the ordinance was amended to allow small hobby type gardens.
