ORDINANCE NO. 2012-204 AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO ADDITIONAL HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR PERSONS 65 AND OLDER; AMENDING SECTION 61-1 BY INCREASING THE ADDITIONAL EXEMPTION TO \$50,000; ADDING SUBPARAGRAPH (b)(2); PROVIDING FOR AN EXEMPTION UP TO THE ASSESSED VALUE OF PROPERTY VALUED AT LESS THEN \$250,000.00 IF THE OWNER HAS OBTAINED THE AGE OF 65 OR OLDER AND THE HOUSE HOLD INCOME DOES NOT EXCEED CERTAIN LIMITATIONS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.**

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve ordinance 2012-204. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Curtis. Mayor Queen explained the revision would currently affect 9 residents and the new 100% exemption would apply to any resident that met the stated parameters.
