**Parking Permits** If you have not updated your parking permit they expire December 2013. Bring in your photo identification to Town Hall for a new permit that will be valid until December 2015. There is no cost to update, only proof of residency.



**Election Dates** Qualifying for Commission Seats 3 and 4 will be December 6<sup>th</sup> – December 20<sup>th</sup>. The election will be held March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014.



**Emergency Contact** If you are going out of town for an extended period of time please give a contact number to a trusted neighbor, or Town Hall, in case of a problem with your home. We have had several instances of broken water pipes or storm damage and could not notify the property owners.



**Neighborhood Safety** If you observe suspicious activity please contact the Sheriff's Office at 727-582-6200 or Town Hall. All of us working together can prevent, or provide information to solve, crimes in our neighborhood.



**Gulf Boulevard** Please pardon the mess while construction continues on Gulf Boulevard. When completed, the newly paved road with new signage, updated crosswalk technology and road striping will add to our town's beauty and safety.



**Garbage Service Problems** All residents must have an account for garbage and recycling services with Waste Services, Inc./Progressive Services.
