



**TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING
MAY 9TH, 2019 MINUTES**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Queen called the May 9th, 2019 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Town Hall building, 190 - 173rd Avenue, North Redington Beach, Florida.

Mayor Queen, Vice Mayor Bennett and Commissioners Curtis, Dahl and Kennedy were present.

PRESENTATION TO TED DAHL

Mayor Queen thanked Commissioner Dahl for his years of service to the town and presented him with an appreciation plaque. Commissioner Dahl expressed his gratitude to be able to serve, thanked everyone for their hard work, and stated NRB would always be his home.
