SECOND AND FINAL READING.**

SECOND AND FINAL READING.

Vice Mayor Bennett made a motion to approve Ordinance 2019-810. Commissioner Thornton seconded the motion. Commissioner Curtis asked about the amendment from the previous meeting as the original ordinance was inadvertently included in the agenda book.
