1. **ORDINANCE NO. 2022-841** AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 98-364 OF DIVISION 1 OF ARTICLE VI OF CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO BRING THE SECTION INTO COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 2021-202, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.
2. **ORDINANCE 2022-842** AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC d/b/a DUKE ENERGY, AN ELECTRIC UTILITY RIGHTS OF WAY UTILIZATION FRANCHISE; PRESCRIBING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE OCCUPANCY OF MUNICIPAL STREETS AND RIGHTS OF WAY IN THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ELECTRIC SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
