Commissioner Curtis asked about code enforcement on gazebos in back yards. Town Clerk Campbell stated that if it can't be seen from the road, it needs to be reported for enforcement to happen. She added the prior violation, that Commissioner Curtis had reported, was being handled by the Code Enforcement Officer.
