Election Qualifying

Qualifying for Commission Seats 3 and 4, currently held by Commissioner Corey Thornton and Vice-Mayor Kevin Kennedy, will open on Friday, December 1st at 8:00 a.m. and close on Friday, December 15th at 1:00 p.m. The election will be on March 19, 2024.

Outdoor Lighting Reminder

Our town ordinance requires all dock and home lighting to be either shielded down or turned off at night. This prevents light from shining into neighboring homes as well as those across the water.

Beach Renourishment

The September 8th meeting, with the Army Corp of Engineers, did not produce any positive steps toward their participation in the renourishment project. North Redington Beach, Belleair Beach and the Sand Key portion of Clearwater have gathered 100% of the easements needed for the project. However, Redington Shores, Indian Shores and Indian Rocks Beach collected approximately 50% of their needed easements. Since this project is a combination of all of the towns, the Army Corp is still requiring 100% compliance from all participants. An emergency project has been approved by Pinellas County and will replenish dunes or install a type of sandbag barrier if previously requested by the property owners. The County is still planning a total renourishment project for the near future. They have begun the engineering and permitting process for the entire Sand Key project (from North Redington Beach to Clearwater).
