- *With one exception, the Town has completed their part of obtaining easements for the completion of the west side of Gulf Boulevard undergrounding. Duke now has the easements to begin the project.*
- *The EMS/Public Works building project should be out for bids next week.*
- *The beach nourishment is still being worked on but looks like the County will be doing the project as the Army Corp has refused to budge on their requirement of 100% easements.*
- *The new Wapro valve on Dolphin Drive is working and there was no water in the street on the last high tide, unlike the previous high tides.*

Commissioner Curtis inquired to the status of Pinellas County taking over the sewer system. Town Clerk Campbell stated they have been in town doing their due diligence and they would provide the town with their findings within 180 days of signing the agreement.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:20 pm.
