NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCY

The Town of North Redington Beach is accepting resumes from any qualified parties wishing to be considered for an appointment to the Board of Commissioners. The appointment will be for the remaining term of Commission Seat 1 ending in March 2027. Resumes must be submitted to the Town Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 3rd. Qualified applicants will be interviewed at a workshop meeting on November 5th at 10:00 am. The appointment will be voted on at the regularly scheduled Commission meeting November 13th.

To qualify, an applicant must be a resident of the Town of North Redington Beach, a citizen of the United States of America and of the State of Florida, and a duly qualified elector registered to vote in Pinellas County and a permanent resident of North Redington Beach for at least one (1) year immediately prior to the date of filing application for town office.

Town Commissioners shall receive a stipend of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per month.
