NEW COMMISSIONER TO BE SWORN IN

After announcing the vacancy of Commission Seat 1, we had 3 residents apply to fill the seat for the remaining term. The Board met yesterday and interviewed all three candidates and declared it the hardest decision they have had to make, as all three candidates were highly qualified and would be an asset to the Town. Each Commissioner interviewed each candidate on a one-on-one basis and assigned a score of 1-10. After the scores were tallied upon completion of the interviews, long-time resident John Messmore will be sworn in at the Commission meeting on November 13th. We look forward to John being a part of the NRB team!

Congratulations to John and a huge thank you to the other applicants for their desire to serve the town and we hope to see them again in the future.

ELECTION DATES

Qualifying for the March 10th, 2026 election begins on December 5th at 8:00 am and closes at 1:00 pm on December 19th. Commission Seats 3 and 4 are up for election for a 2-year term ending in 2028. Anyone interested in qualifying may pick up a packet beginning November 18th.

SECOND READING OF COMP PLAN AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

The Town has received approval from the state of the first reading of the comprehensive plan amendment ordinance that was passed in October. The second reading has been set for a Special Meeting on Friday, November 21st at 10:00 am as it once again must go back to the State for another 30-day review. Once this review is complete, the Board can then hear the second reading of the ordinance to increase the building height of single family residences that was passed on first reading in October.

PINELLAS COUNTY UTILITIES OPEN HOUSE

Pinellas County Utilities will hold an open house at Town Hall on Wednesday, November 19th from 5:30 – 6:30 pm to answer any questions regarding the upcoming transfer of the sewer system on December 2nd.

Your billing should look the same as the County has been doing the billing for the Town for the last twenty plus years. The amount will change with you seeing a decrease or increase depending on your usage, as explained in previous newsletters.
