



**TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING
NOVEMBER 13TH, 2025**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Super called the November 13th, 2025 meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Town Hall building, 190 - 173rd Avenue, North Redington Beach, Florida.

Mayor Super, Vice Mayor Kennedy and Commissioners Nagrabski and Thornton were present. Staff present was Attorney Jay Daigneault and Town Clerk Mari Campbell.

APPOINTMENT AND SWEARING IN OF JOHN MESSMORE – COMMISSIONER SEAT 1

Mayor Super stated the Commission had interviewed three very good candidates to fill the vacancy for Commission Seat 1. He further stated John Messmore had received the highest score among the candidates and would fill the vacancy through the remainder of the term ending in March 2027 upon appointment. Vice Mayor Kennedy made a motion to appoint Mr. Messmore to Commission Seat 1. Commissioner Nagrabski seconded the motion.

1. **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-885** AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, CREATING SECTION 98-370. – “CERTIFIED RECOVERY RESIDENCES” OF DIVISION I, ARTICLE VI, CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, REGARDING THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CERTIFIED RECOVERY RESIDENCES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING.

Vice Mayor Kennedy made a motion to approve Ordinance No 2025-885, Commissioner Nagrabski seconded the motion.

Town Attorney Daigneault explained this ordinance was required by recently passed state legislation. The requirements were already in place through other means but not by code and the legislation assists in destigmatizing recovery.

During Public input Mr. Curtis asked what defined a certified recovery residence. The Board discussed that recovery residences are required to be allowed in all zoning districts. A roll call vote was taken.

2. **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-886** AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 98 – “ZONING,” ARTICLE VI. – “SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS,” DIVISION 3. – “WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITIES,” BY AMENDING SECTION 98-401 – “PURPOSE AND INTENT,” SECTION 98-402 – “WIRELESS COMMUNICATION ANTENNAE,” AND SECTION 98-403 – “WIRELESS COMMUNICATION SUPPORT FACILITIES” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE COLOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION

less restrictive.*
