
BOAT PARADE COMMITTEE

PARKING PERMITS

If you haven't yet picked up your new resident parking permit, stop by Town Hall to get a new one which is good through 2027.

OUTDOOR LIGHTING

Town ordinance requires all dock and home lighting to be either shielded or turned off at night. This prevents light from shining into neighboring homes as well as those across the water.

BULK PICK UP


BEACH REMINDER
