ELECTRIC BICYCLES

Following reports of many near misses between autos and electric bicycles riding (often in the wrong direction) on sidewalks, the Commission has approved a first reading of an ordinance prohibiting the use of electric bicycles on sidewalks within the town, including Gulf Boulevard. As the motorized bikes will have to be ridden on the street, they are required to ride in the direction of traffic hopefully preventing those near misses from becoming actual accidents.
