- 1. ORDINANCE NO 2026-888** - AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, ADDING SECTION 62-62 TO ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF ELECTRIC BICYCLES ON THE TOWN'S SIDEWALKS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
