1. **ORDINANCE NO 2026-888 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF NORTH REDINGTON BEACH, FLORIDA, ADDING SECTION 62-62 TO ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF ELECTRIC BICYCLES ON THE TOWN'S SIDEWALKS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. FIRST READING**

Commissioner Thornton made a motion to approve Ordinance No 2026-888, Commissioner Messmore seconded the motion.

Town Attorney Daigneault explained that the board had discussed the safety issues with e-bikes at the previous workshop meeting. Town Attorney Daigneault researched what steps the town could take to regulate motorized bicycles to help improve the safety of all involved and had drafted an ordinance which prohibits electric bicycles on all sidewalks within the town. Commissioner Messmore stated he was happy the town was taking steps to improve safety as he has had close calls with motorized bikes on Gulf Boulevard sidewalks. Vice Mayor Kennedy thanked Commissioner Messmore for bringing the bike issue to the board. There was no public input. A roll call vote was taken.
