EMS/PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING UPDATE

The construction of the new EMS/Public Works building is continuing at a rapid rate, well on pace to meet the March 2027 completion date.



PARK VANDALISM

Vandals have been targeting our parks in town and using the wheels of their bikes to burn offensive words and images into the surface of the gazebo at Radcliffe Park and basketball court at Baldanza Park. PARKING/CONSTRUCTION

As we come upon two years post storm, there continues to be much construction throughout town. The restriction of parking on one side of the road is still suspended due to the extreme amount of construction vehicles. The Sheriff's Deputies have been instructed to allow parking on both sides of the road but that vehicles cannot be parked in such a way that the road is blocked. If this occurs, the vehicles must be moved.

BUDGET HEARING DATES

The annual budget meetings have been scheduled. This year's meetings will be on September 9th at 5:05 pm and again on September 18th at 5:05 pm.

BEACH RENOURISHMENT AGREEMENT

After 11 years of negotiations, Pinellas County completed an agreement with Army Corps of Engineers for future beach restorations.

The Army Corps of Engineers and Pinellas County signed an agreement in which the ACE will return to paying 65% of beach renourishment projects.
